Entrepreneurship Development in Higher Education (EDHE) in partnership with Durban University of Technology, Universities South Africa (USAF) and The National Department of Higher Education and Training (DHET) is pleased to announce the EDHE Lekgotla 2019. The gathering will take place at the Durban International Convention Centre (ICC) on 25 - 28 June 2019.

In its third successive edition, the Lekgotla seeks to raise awareness, showcase and celebrate entrepreneurship as an alternative to formal employment from all disciplines. This year's Lekgotla is an opportunity for the faculties of the creative arts, language and media, and business development at the various institutions affiliated with USAF to discuss and share innovative entrepreneurial and third-stream income practices; network and build partnerships with one another and most importantly, showcase and celebrate the work of creative and innovative studententrepreneurs.

The various exhibitions, installations and activations, which form part of the Lekgotla, will reframe practices and stimulate "out of the box" thinking and learning, delve into outside spaces, forgotten heritages and innovation in street-wise activities.

We hereby invite participating higher education institutions to send submissions of work for exhibition purposes that can demonstrate the focus of the Lekgotla as described above, as well as fulfil the following criteria:

**Criteria for selection:**

- The work must be focussed on the fields that encompass entrepreneurship in the creative industries and players in the creative economy. This includes but is not exclusive to: visual art, jewellery and fashion design, photography, performance art, digital design, music, film, graphic and interior design.
- Two entries per university will be accepted. This may include work by post-graduate students in the 2019 year and is not open to staff unless it is as a collaborative piece or project between students and staff.
- Where institutions submit more than two potential exhibits for review, only two will be selected.
- The entry will be completed work or demonstrable work in progress with proposed solutions. In all instances, the work must be exhibition ready.
- The work must be creative and demonstrate a focus on innovative business or entrepreneurial ideas.
- The work must be able to fit into a space of 3m x 3m (9 sqm) per individual submission.

**Submission requirements**

- Submit a 500 word letter of motivation, arguing the relevance of the proposed exhibit to the EDHE Lekgotla 2019.
- Provide a 250-word concept statement.
- Each entry must be accompanied by a 250-word biography of the exhibitors.
- Provide a minimum of five (5) high-resolution images of the proposed works (details) and 2 high-resolution images of exhibition ready final work.
- A plan and clear installation and/or presentation instructions. All work must be able to be installed within the allocated space.
- The EDHE Lekgotla 2019 selection panel reserves the right to reject submissions that do not meet the professional standards it seeks to set with this event.
- All related costs for exhibiting (shipping & installation consumables) are the responsibility of the exhibitor.
- The organisers/hosts will not be liable for any damage to or theft of the exhibitors work.
